

A MOTORCOACH GUIDE TO OCEAN CITY



Permits and Parking

Motorcoach permits are handled by the OC Department of Tourism. We are committed to making this a quick and easy process, and permits are free if you are parking at a hospitality partner-hotel, restaurant, amusement attraction or retail facility, but they must be displayed **year-round**.

Parking is available at the West Ocean City Park & Ride at 12848 Ocean Gateway, Ocean City, MD 21842 with your permit and a nominal \$10 fee. To request your permit, call 410-289-2800.

While at the OC Park & Ride, please enjoy the facilities and the surrounding shopping and eateries. Please do not run motors at this facility, as residential areas near the west side fence monitor noise and fumes. The Town of Ocean City enjoys providing parking for motorcoaches while striving to be good neighbors to surrounding residents.

DIRECTIONS TO OCEAN CITY INLET PARKING LOT

1. Enter Ocean City (either by Rt. 50 or Rt. 90).
2. Turn right onto Coastal Hwy, which becomes Philadelphia Ave.
3. Follow Philadelphia Ave. all the way to the end, staying in the right lane.
4. Follow S-curve until you approach the gate.
5. Take a ticket from the machine.
6. Proceed around the outer lanes of the parking lot until you reach Souvenir City and the Tram Station.
7. Drop off your passengers as quickly as possible to avoid being charged.

*You may pick up your passengers following the same procedure.

DIRECTIONS TO PARK & RIDE FROM INLET PARKING LOT

1. Exit the Inlet Parking Lot.
2. Stay in the left lane while on Baltimore Ave.
3. Turn left onto 1st Street.
4. Turn left onto Philadelphia Ave.
5. Bear right and go over the Rt. 50 bridge.
6. Turn left at the first light to enter the OC Park & Ride.

*There is a bus that runs seasonally from the OC Park & Ride into Ocean City, if the bus driver would like to come into town after parking the bus.

Visiting the Boardwalk?

809 South Atlantic Avenue

Follow the signs to the Inlet Parking Area at the southernmost point of town. Buses are allowed a limited time to discharge and board passengers in season. Follow the lane next to the Boardwalk Tram Center. During festivals, OC Police will direct you to the boardwalk. The South Division Street Transit Center is reserved for the use of OC Municipal buses only. Please refrain from using the Center as a staging or drop off point.

Residential Restrictions

Commercial vehicles are prohibited in all residential neighborhoods as well as some other areas of the resort.
